

### SMARTER MAIL setup pop3 account with SSL in Microsoft Outlook 2016

- 1. Launch your Microsoft Outlook 2016.
- From Top left menu, click on FILE > make sure that Info is selected on the left> click on

 Enter your full email address > click on "Advanced options" > tick the checkbox "Let me set up my account manually" then Connect.

- 5. Enter mail.domain.com for Incoming and Outgoing mail server (SMTP).
- Check the checkbox "This server requires an encrypted connection (SSL/TLS)" for Incoming mail server.

Select "SSL/TLS" under Encryption method for Outgoing mail server.

7. Assign 995 for incoming port (POP3) and 465 for outgoing port (SMTP).
